Mr. Craig Tripp, Chairman called the meeting to order; Mr. Jeff Harper led in the Pledge of Allegiance and Mr. Randy Sexton offered the invocation.

Fiscal Year End 2019 Proposed Budget Amendment:

Mrs. Cindy Scheer presented the proposed 2019 budget amendment for review. General Fund revenue was amended to \$691,534.00 from \$698,181.96. Expenses were amended to \$329,511.00 from \$561,118.00, which includes a transfer of \$75,000.00 to the enterprise fund. This represents a \$362,023.00 surplus to the General Fund. Enterprise Fund revenue was amended to \$100,645.00 from \$307,000.00 this also includes the General Fund transfer of \$75,000.00. Expenses were amended to \$101,075.00 from \$292,450.00. This represents a deficit of \$430.00. The net increase to the District Funds projected at \$361,593.00. A motion was made by Mr. Jeffery Barnard to accept the amended budget as presented; second by Mr. Jeff Harper – motion pasted unanimously by show of hands.

Fiscal Year End 2020 Proposed Budget:

Mrs. Cindy Scheer presented the proposed budget for fiscal year end June 2020. General Fund revenue is projected at \$655,223.00; projected expenses \$287,513.00 and \$30,000.00 transfer to Enterprise fund. The total expense including transfer is \$317,513.00 – this represents a surplus of \$337,710.00 to the General Fund. Enterprise fund revenue \$71,894.00 including a transfer from General Fund of \$30,000.00; projected expenses \$59,260.00 – this represents a surplus of \$12,634.00. Net increase to District's funds is \$330,147.00. General Fund balance at beginning of year \$4,422,641.00; Estimate General Fund Balance at year end \$4,760,351.00. Mr. Jeff Harper made a motion to adopt the proposed budget for fiscal year end 2020 with the net increase of funds in the amount of \$330,147.00 to be published for public comment; second by Mr. Jeffery Barnard. Motion pasted unanimously by show of hands.

2019 Millage Rate Approval

Mr. Jeff Harper made the motion to adopt the 2019 millage rate of 5.14 mills by the following resolution; second by Mr. Lamar Smith. Vote taken by roll call – Barnard – Yes, Harper – Yes, Sexton – Yes, L. Smith – Yes, Tripp – Yes and Vercher – Yes. Nays: 0; Abstained: 0; Absent: 0
